The critical challenge/barrier we have had in the last year and a half is recruiting a skilled and experienced case management individual who is willing to move to a rural community, and work later afternoon to evening and weekend hours. Just this month, Calaveras Behavioral Health Services completed a second round of interviews, and have selected a candidate (with mutual agreement with the Sheriff Department) that now needs to pass a lengthy background check before starting in mid-May or early June, 2015. Once in the position, we intend to send the individual to a three or four day Crisis Intervention Training in Yolo County. We strongly believe that once this new service is implemented – we will be able to easily document that we are meeting a critical need in our community.
