Sacramento County, Division of Behavioral Health Services (DBHS) has completed the RFP process for our Triage Personnel Program. DBHS is pleased to announce that the grant was awarded to TLCS, Inc. DBHS anticipates contract execution with TLCS no later than June 2015.

During this past quarter, DBHS and TLCS have been and are in discussions regarding program start-up and implementation with partners who are directly affiliated with the access points where triage services will be provided. They include Sacramento County Main Jail, Dignity Health, Kaiser, Sutter Health, UCDCMC, Loaves & Fishes.

TLCS is currently recruiting for the program director and will soon recruit for the Triage and Peer Navigator positions. DBHS has assigned a .25 Program Planner to begin the process of collecting and analyzing data for reporting and evaluation. As defined on DBHS' proposal, we are leveraging a Mental Health Program Coordinator to provide oversight of the contract. Additionally, DBHS is leveraging other staff, not defined in our proposal, to establish and maintain collaborative relationships with our partners and to assist with the implementation planning for this program.
