**4. Comments**

The Crisis Assessment, Prevention & Education (CAPE) Team has hired a full time Clinical Specialist, and anticipates hiring 3 additional clinicians within the next month. We are in the background process on new candidates at the time of this writing. We have added Sonoma Valley, Healdsburg, Windsor, and Cloverdale High Schools for mobile crisis response, and are working with the schools to schedule suicide prevention trainings in the classrooms and for faculty.

The Mobile Support Team (MST) is in the process of hiring 2 new clinicians in the next month, plus 2 additional post-graduate clinical interns being hired by a contract agency. MST is meeting with police departments in Cotati, Rohnert Park, and Petaluma to schedule cross trainings and ride-alongs with law
