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**4. Comments**

Contract Staff :

Peer Providers: The original grant application included 4 .0 FTE Peer Support Personnel, however all outreach needs are being met with current personnel. More may be added when/if the need requires additional staffing in this position. This change also allowed for an increase in the pay rate provided to clinicians as recruitment efforts were slow and required this adjustment to fill open positions.

Clinicians: The original grant included 4.0 FTE Crisis Response Clinicians, The services in the grant were expanded to include response to calls for early psychosis outreach and screening. This was made possible by adding state funds to address earmarked for early identification of those experiencing first episode psychosis. This expanded the Clinician FTE's to 5.0.

Locations of service:

Triage staff are located at all listed addresses with crisis response and outreach services being provided in the community throughout Yolo County.
