Support for Survivors of Suicide Loss Napa County

The Napa County Suicide Prevention Council actively supports survivors of suicide loss with resources, education, and professional support throughout the year. Our council keeps a trilingual, updated Survivors of Suicide Resource card in the hands of professionals who interact with survivors and offers personalized support from individuals who have lost loved ones to suicide.

Our Survivors of Suicide Loss workgroup hosts an International Survivors of Suicide Loss Day each November, where survivors of suicide loss come together to find connection, understanding, and hope through their shared experience. This past November, our Napa County council partnered with Solano County Behavioral Health's Suicide Prevention Committee to offer a multi-county event in partnership with the Solano County Behavioral Health's Suicide Prevention Committee, which included a film screening, breakout sessions, grief support and a keynote speaker.
