

Mental Health Student Services Act (MHSSA) Technical Coaching Assistance Grant










Purpose and Goals

The purpose of the Technical Coaching Assistance Grant is to establish a **Technical Coaching Team (TCT or Coaching)** to assist MHSSA grantees statewide.

Technical Coaching will be provided in **four distinct subject areas**, by three different MHSSA grantee counties. These four subject areas were identified by the MHSOAC (Commission) as creating barriers to success for MHSSA programs.

The four subject areas and county grantees are:

- Data Collection Tehama County Department of Education (TCDE)
- Partnership Development Imperial County Office of Education (ICOE)
- **Program Implementation** Placer County Office of Education (PCOE)
- Sustainability Imperial County Office of Education (ICOE)



Purpose and Goals

The **immediate goal** of the Technical Assistance Coaching Grant is to provide technical assistance to all MHSSA grantees on a statewide basis.

This will be accomplished in two ways:

- Technical assistance support and direct consultation to other MHSSA grantees; and
- 2. Support of a web-based information hub to be developed by a third-party Statewide Coordinator.

MHSSA grantees requesting technical coaching will be connected to a **Technical Coaching Team member or lead** who will work together with a **Statewide Coordinator** to develop a range of strategies to **build the capacity** for excellent student mental health programs throughout the state.







Statewide Coordinator



The goal for the Statewide Coordinator is to collectively develop a range of strategies to build the capacity for comprehensive student mental health systems.

The Statewide Coordinator will:

- Act as project lead and subject matter expert for statewide technical assistance for Mental Health Student Services Act grantees working in collaboration with the Technical Coaching Teams and the Commission.
- Establish statewide and/or regional technical assistance learning collaboratives for interested grantees.
- Develop and maintain a centralized webpage to receive and share information and resources with TCTs and MHSSA grantees.
